Re: Additions to the Medical Assistance Fee Schedule for Monkeypox Laboratory Testing and Vaccines

Keystone First/Keystone First CHC will follow the guidelines issued on July 26, 2022, by the Department of Human Service (DHS) Medical Assistance Bulletin (MAB) (01-22-41) outlining the addition of newly created Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes for Monkeypox laboratory testing and vaccines.

Effective July 26, 2022, the following CPT codes have been added to the Keystone First/Keystone First CHC fee schedule. The rate for the administration of the vaccine is \$10.00.
