Dear Keystone First Community HealthChoices (CHC) Primary Care Provider,

Keystone First CHC is making the following changes to the Total Cost of Care (TCOC) Program for 2025.

New Program Component:

Health Equity Component – Primary care providers who meet or exceed the 50th percentile when compared to their peers will be awarded an additional increase in their total earned incentive with regard to the following measures for their African American and Hispanic/Latino population: Controlling High Blood Pressure and Breast Cancer Screening

Existing Program Components:

The Quality Performance component of the Total Cost of Care Program will continue to consist of the following HEDIS® based measures:

- Adults' Access to Preventive/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP)
- Adult Immunizations Status (AIS-E)
- Asthma Medication Ratio (AMR)
- Glycemic Status Assessment for Patients with Diabetes (GSD) (<8%)
- Kidney Health Evaluation for Patients with Diabetes (KED)
- Eye Exam for Patients with Diabetes (EED)
- Controlling High Blood Pressure <140/90 mm Hg (CBP)
- Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS)
- Plan All Cause Readmissions (PCR)
- Breast Cancer Screening (BCS-E)


This program is based on an actual versus expected medical cost calculation that allows for an incentive payment based on how well you managed the health of your Home- and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Non-Dual and Nursing Facility Ineligible (NFI) Dual Aligned Participants throughout the calendar year.
